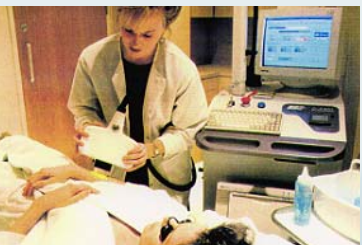

Laser Tattoo Removal

In this brochure, we will try to answer some of the common questions we have encountered regarding laser tattoo removal. If you have further questions, you may contact us at any time and one of our dermatologists will be happy to answer any further questions you may have.

Is the process painful?

The laser emits light in very short flashes called pulses. The impact of the energy from the powerful pulse of light is similar to the snap of a thin rubber band. The large majority of patients do not require anesthesia.

How many treatment sessions will it take to remove the tattoo?

On the average, professional tattoos require 6 to 10 treatments with 6 being the average, spaced approximately one month apart. Amateur tattoos require even fewer treatments. The number of treatments depends on the amount and type of ink used and the depth of the ink in the skin. Rarely, more than ten treatments may be needed.

Do all colours of ink disappear equally as well?

No. Dark inks (blue or black) and red inks fade the best. Oranges, greens and purples usually respond well too. Yellow inks are the most difficult to remove, although additional treatments can produce significant fading.

Will the tattoo completely disappear?

In most cases, yes. More than 95% fading of the tattoo is usually accomplished. However, it is very important to know that over 100 tattoo inks are in use worldwide today, none of which are regulated by the FDA. Not knowing which tattoo ink was used, how deep it went or the quantity used makes it impossible for the physician to predict the degree of removal on any given tattoo.

What type of care is required after the laser treatment?

Usually there will be pinpoint bleeding associated with the treatment and occasionally a blister may form. An antibacterial ointment and a dressing may be applied to

the area. The treated area should be kept clean with continued application of an ointment given to you by your physician. A shower can be taken the next day, although the treated area should not be scrubbed.

What are the side effects?

Almost all tattoos can be removed without any scars or skin changes. Rarely, a white mark or scar can occur. Generally there is neither scarring nor any long-term side effects.
